Villa Maria Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) Herbal characters on the nose with flavors of grapefruit and lime.	9	27
Kendall Jackson “Vintners Reserve” Chardonnay (California) Tropical flavors of mango and pineapple meld with aromas of peach, apple and pear. Finishes with nuances of creamy, vanilla oak.	10	30
Chateau St. Michelle Riesling (Washington State) Subtle lemon and mineral notes leads to a juicy peach, apricot, pear and sweet citrus finish. Goes well with most asian dishes!	7	21
14 Hands Merlot (Washington State) Flavors of dark plum, blueberry, mocha, and a hint of cocoa.	7	21
